# PRIVATE COMMISSION DUNEDIN, NEW ZEALAND

Door Panels (two windows, each 0.22m x 0.62m) 2010

Helen Whittaker was commissioned to design a pair of door panels representing the Northern and Southern hemispheres, the clients previous and present home in New Zealand.

Three images represent significant elements associated with the clients:-

The central image depicts the Cross of St. George representing the unity of Great Britain and New Zealand. It is flanked by an image representing the Southern hemisphere containing New Zealand Bell Birds and Koru fern against a warm gold background. The Northern Hemisphere contains the Celtic Carew Cross from Pembrokeshire and surrounding beech leaves set against a cold blue background. The blue and gold colours are shared by the flags of Otago, New Zealand and Pembrokeshire, UK.
