The window tracery sections celebrate the works of past and present flower arrangers of St. Peter's Church.

The dedication of the church to St. Peter is depicted with his crossed keys set in the apex tracery. The keys are overlaid upon St. Peter's cross that radiates against a background of mid-night sky.

The lower two quatrefoil traceries depict flora associated with the seasons with Spring and Summer celebrated with Primroses, Snowdrops, Lilies, Wild Roses and Poppies, and Autumn and Winter represented by Acorns, Daisies, Christmas Roses, Snow Drops, Holly and Ivy.

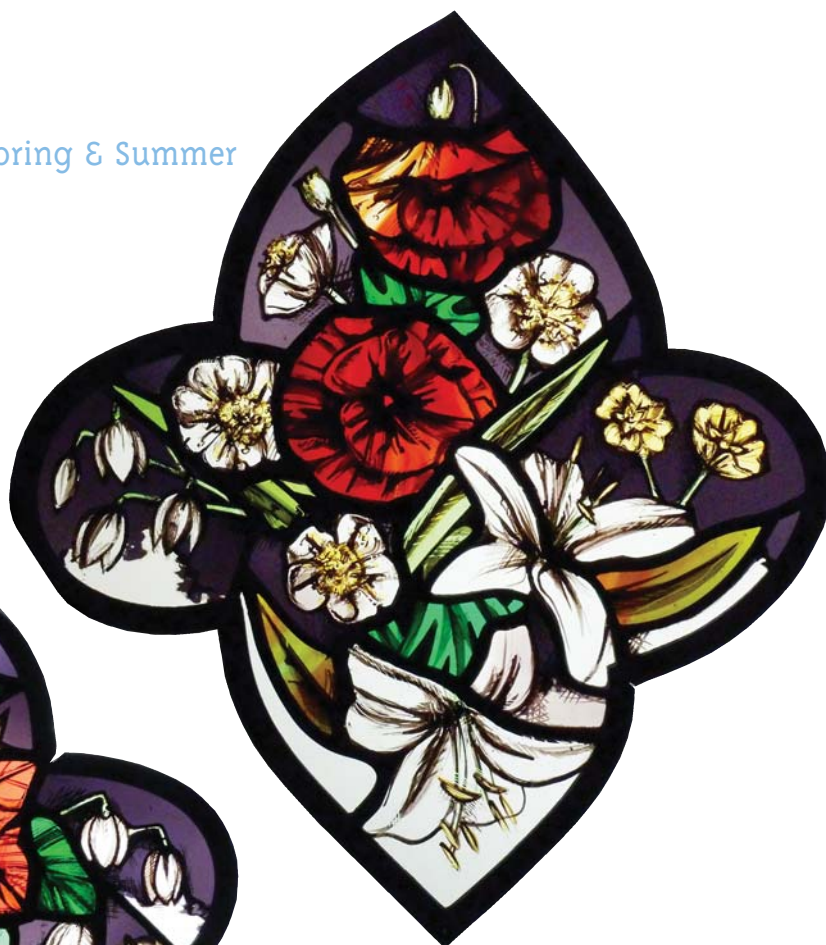
